

STOCK MARKET REPORT

- The domestic equities market lost steam in July 2021 as a confluence of factors negatively affected investor sentiment. These include an unexpected temporary suspension of vaccinations in a number of local government units due to supply constraints; the rise in Delta variant cases locally and internationally; and the announcement of the reimposition of a two-week enhanced community quarantine in Metro Manila set to commence in August. The benchmark PSE Index capped the month at 6,270.23 points, down by 9.2% or 631.68 points from a closing level of 6,901.91 points in June 2021. On a year-to-date basis, the PSEi fell by 12.2% or 869.48 points from 7,139.71 points at the end of 2020.
- Five of six sector indices charted the same downward trajectory, with the Property index recording
 the largest month-on-month loss at 11.7%. This was followed by the Holding Firms, Financials,
 Industrial, and Services indices as they declined by 9.5%, 9.2%, 6.9%, and 4.1%, respectively. The
 broader All Shares index also mirrored the downbeat sentiment as it shaved off 7.3% or 309.72
 points to cap July at 3,934.96 points from 4,244.58 points the prior month. The All Shares index
 was likewise 7.9% or 337.75 points lower compared to its 2020 close of 4,272.61 points.
- The total market value of companies listed on the PSE stood at P15.76 trillion in July 2021, a
 decrease of 5.6% from the P16.70 trillion total market capitalization (MCAP) recorded in the month
 before. Total MCAP for the month was likewise 0.8% lower in comparison to the 2020 year-end
 figure of P15.89 trillion. Meanwhile, domestic MCAP ended July at a value of P12.53 trillion, down
 by 6.1% from P13.35 trillion the previous month. Year-to-date, the value of domestic shares slid by
 4.4% from P13.10 trillion at the close of 2020.
- Total value turnover in July 2021 declined by 29.8% to P123.22 billion from the P175.44 billion total value traded the prior month. Year-on-year, the latest figure likewise dropped by 1.3% from P124.81 billion in July 2020. Meanwhile, the average value of shares traded through PSE on a daily basis contracted by 26.4% month-on-month to P5.87 billion from P7.97 billion. However, average daily value turnover for July remained up by 3.4% as compared to the P5.67 billion average in the same month last year.

For the first seven months of the year, total value turnover expanded by 32.8% to P1.22 trillion from P916 billion in the comparable period in 2020. Consequently, average daily value turnover in the January to June period rose by 31.8% to P8.51 billion from P6.45 billion a year ago.

Foreign investors moved deeper into selling territory in July 2021, as P9.15 billion worth of foreign capital rotated out of the local market, wider than both the foreign selling value of P4.18 billion last month and P6.90 billion in July 2020. Foreign investors accounted for 35.3% of market activity during the month. For the seven-month period ending July, foreign transactions yielded a selling amount of P87.02 billion, 15.7% wider than the P75.19 billion net selling figure in the same period a year ago. On a year-to-date basis, the share of foreign transactions to total market trades likewise fell to 32.8% from 50.2% last year.
